

The 2019 High Life Study Survey Prize Draw Terms and Conditions

1. Instructions on how to enter and other details contained within The High Life Study invitation email and survey form part of the conditions of entry.
2. By entering the competition, entrants agree to abide by these Terms and Conditions.
3. The competition is being run by RMIT University, GPO Box 2476, Melbourne, Victoria, 3001 ("RMIT University").
4. The High Life Study Survey Prize Draw ("the competition") commences at 8.00am Australian Eastern Standard Time (AEST) on Thursday, 13th May 2020.
5. The closing time for entering the competition is 7.00pm AEST on Thursday 18th June 2020.
6. Entry to the competition is limited to people aged 18 years and over who complete The High Life Study survey.
7. To enter the competition, the entrant must:
 - (a) Complete the High Life Study survey online before the closing time; and
 - (b) Answer 'yes' to the question, 'Would you like to be entered into the prize draw to win one of 10 x \$100 Coles and Myer group vouchers?', and provide an email address for contact.
8. Entry to the competition is free. Entrants will be responsible for all costs associated with entering the competition, which may include costs associated with accessing the internet.
9. Entrants may only enter the competition once.
10. Staff employed by RMIT University and their immediate family members are not eligible to enter the competition.
11. There will be ten (10) prizes of a \$100 Coles Group and Myer gift voucher. Prize values are GST inclusive and are in Australian dollars.
12. The draw will be held at 4pm AEST on Monday, 22nd June 2020 at 124 LaTrobe St Melbourne VIC 3000. The draw will be conducted by random number generator. Each entry is assigned a unique and sequential identifying number. Using the RANDOM.ORG Random Integer Generator, ten (10) numbers will be identified as the prize winners.
13. The prize winners will be contacted within three (3) days of the draw by the email address supplied by the entrant on the survey.
14. If the prize winner does not respond to claim the prize within twenty-one (21) days of the draw, a re-draw will be conducted within thirty (30) days of the original draw date, in the same location, and with the same method. Redraws will continue in the same manner until all prizes have been claimed by prize winners.
15. The prize may be mailed or emailed to the winners.
16. By entering the competition the entrant agrees that they are 18 years of age or over.
17. The prize is not redeemable for cash or an alternative prize.
18. The prize is not transferrable.
19. The prize winners' first name and suburb will be published on the RMIT University website (cur.org.au/project/high-life-study). By entering the competition, entrants grant RMIT University permission to use their first name and suburb on its website for up to six months from the date of the draw.
20. RMIT University's decision will be final and no correspondence will be entered into.
